
Faculty Women's Association





The Weber State College Faculty Women's Association was established in 1935. When first organized, the members were

women or spouses of full time employees of the college. The organization expanded to include faculty members, administrative staff, retired faculty members, and spouses of faculty, the Institutional Council, or State Board of Higher Education. The purpose of the organization was to promote social fellowship and to render service toward the growth of a greater college. The dues would go towards social events and donations to different organizations and departments. Through the years, the organization raised funds for student scholarships, shoes for school children, performing arts, World War II efforts, the Weber College Building fund, and to different departments and organizations on campus. The group was disbanded in 1984 due to the growth of the college and decline in interest.
